# STATE GUIDELINES

## CALIFORNIA STATE GUIDELINES SUMMARY (NEXT 21 DAYS)

- Attendance limited to (25% capacity) or a maximum of 100 people whatever is less
- Maintain Physical Distancing
- Congregants strongly recommended to wear face masks
- Congregants screen for temperature
- Disinfect AV & worship equipment
- Disinfect high traffic areas
- Open doors for fresh air flow
- Do not pass offering plates or communion
- Guidelines in effect for next 21 days



# OC HEALTH GUIDELINES

## ORANGE COUNTY CALIFORNIA

- Self-screen (take the temperature at home)
- Self Isolate (if you've been diagnosed with Covid-19 for a period of 10 days)
- Self Isolate (if you show Covid-19 symptoms for at least 3 days (fever, cough, shortness of breath))
- Self Isolate (if you have tested positive for Covid-19 for at least 10 days from the test date)
- Self-quarantine if you've been exposed to someone with Covid-19 for 14 days
- Wear a cloth face covering
- Maintain Physical distancing protocols
- Maintain disinfecting protocols





# **WHO SHOULD ATTEND IN PERSON SERVICES?**

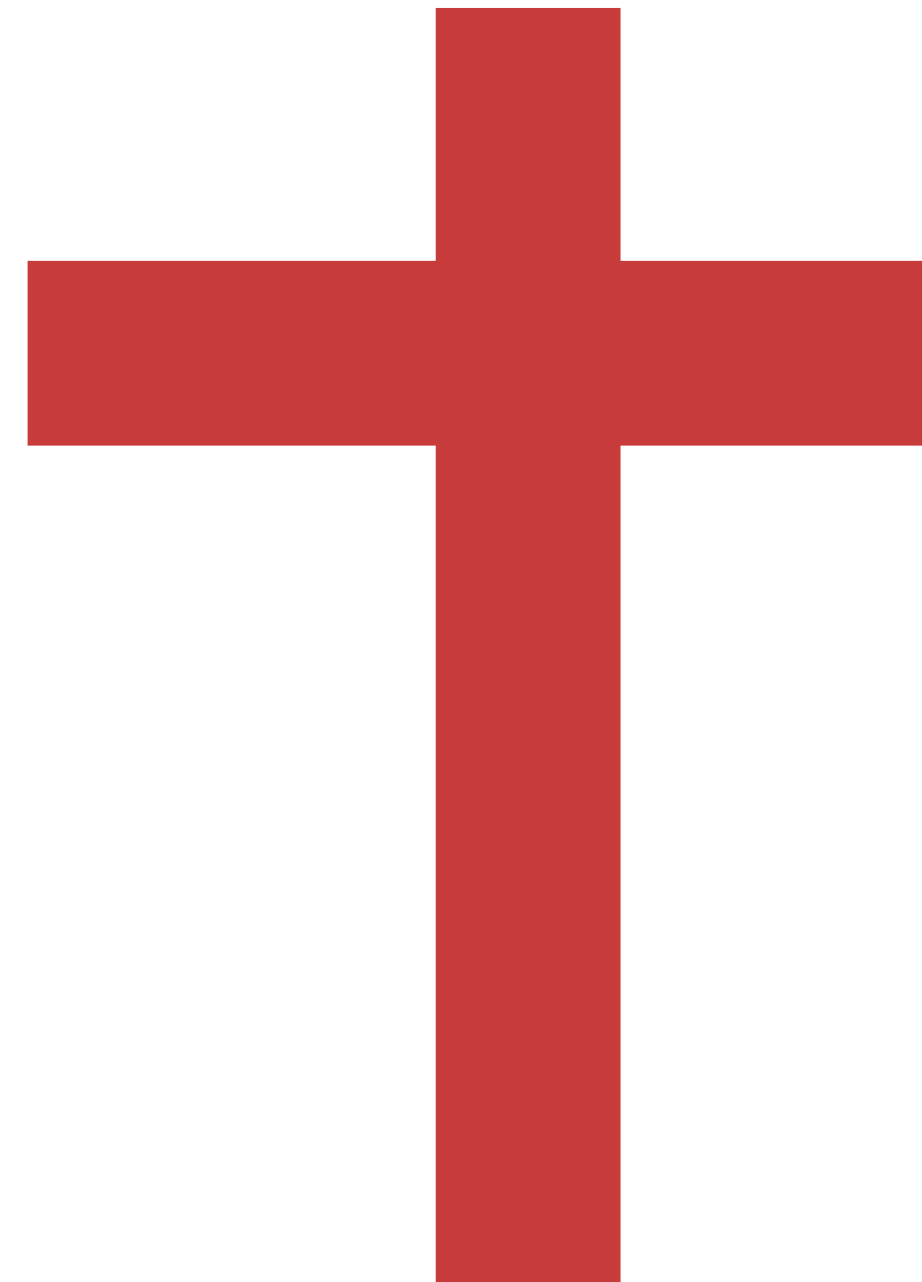
- Those who are healthy

# IN PERSON GUIDELINES

## Temporary safety guidelines in accordance with State and Local authorities

- Due to the limited seating, we would ask those wishing to attend an in-person service to reserve a spot online beforehand.
- Those attending online will stop first at the canopy to be temperature screened and asked to follow the safety guidelines outlined above
- All staff and servants will be screened upon entering earlier in preparation for ministry
- We will ask whenever possible people to wear masks unless there is a specific reason the mask may not be feasible. (leading worship, preaching, or immediate health issue)
- Seating will maintain physical distancing guidelines. Families may sit together. We ask that when people register for service they indicate their total family members attending with them. If we can accommodate we will do our best to have them sit together.
- We ask that we be respectful and loving regarding everyone's personal space at this time. We would ask that all greetings as loving and well-intended as they may be, be done with each other's consent.
- We would also ask that if a person is not able (physically or emotionally) to follow these guidelines at this time that they enjoy being able to worship online.
- We pray that by following these guidelines we can move quickly to a time where the guidelines become less restrictive and more people can join together in worship.
- We believe all of these things should be done with a heart of love toward Jesus, each-other, our community, and as a witness to the non-believers who are observing our conduct.
